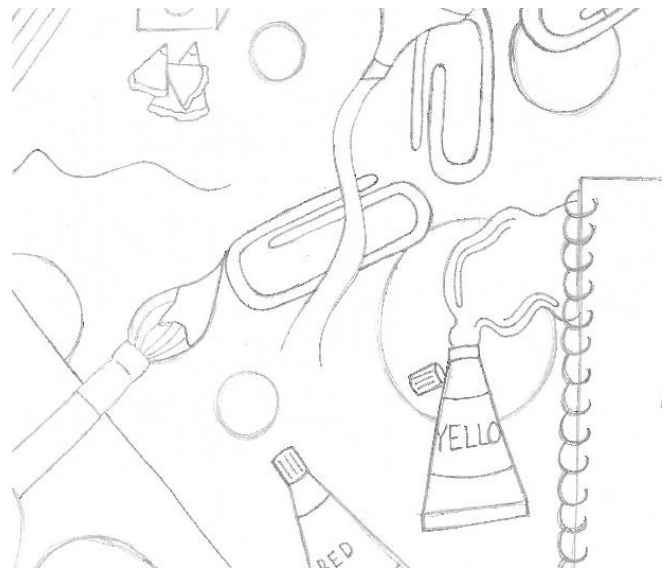


How to get started guide:

1 – start by planning your outline on paper with pencil, keep a rubber handy in case you make any mistakes. I have used stationary as a theme, the artist (see previous page) Michael Craig Martin uses everyday objects, or you could use repeated shapes like Piet Mondrian (see squares previous page.)



2 – once you have your template, you are ready to start colouring. You could choose to use only a few colours, stick to a theme of just blues or pinks for example, or make it your own using any colours you can get your hands on.



Optional Step

3 – When you have finished all the colouring, you might want to go over the outlines to make them stand out more. To do this use a black pen or felt tip.
